REPORTS

Parents will receive a report at the end of the second and fourth terms. At the end of the first and third terms, a comprehensive verbal report back will be held with each set of parents.

Parents can make appointments to see the teachers at any time during the year.

TEACHERS

Your child will be educated by teachers who are experienced and who have the knowledge to help a learning disabled child. All staff members are carefully monitored to ensure that the children are taught in a happy, secure environment.

ASSESSMENTS

The Johannesburg Child Assessment Centre makes use of the classrooms after hours for private assessments. They have a team of specialists and are highly recommended. Parents may choose their own educational therapists to do an assessment on their children.

Speech and occupational therapy can be arranged during school hours by our resident therapists if your child is in need of additional individualized therapy. OT and speech therapy are paid by the parents to the therapists. Remedial therapy, for those who need it, is provided by the school.

MAINTENANCE

Craiglands is responsible for the maintenance and insurance of all school facilities. The environment will be kept as child-safe as possible.

INJURIES

If a child should be injured during play or while participating in an activity, the parents will be contacted if deemed necessary and the parents must cover the financial cost.

FINANCES

The finances will be monitored and controlled by head and bursar of the school. All accounts and expenditure shall be kept on record.

SCHOOL FEES

Enrolment fee: R3 000.00

Monthly **R7 592 per month February to November**

Fees must be paid by the 7th of every month. Please co-operate in this regard. Parents who are unable to pay the school fees will be asked to remove their child and apply elsewhere.

A term's notice must be given if the child is to leave the school

SECURITY

There is a security guard at the Rutland Avenue gate from 6am until the last child has left aftercare in the afternoon. The amount will be added to your account. The cost is R250/month over 10 months or R2 500 if you are paying upfront.

Aftercare Fees are paid into the same account.

SCHOOL TIMES

School begins at 7.40am every day and closes at 1:30pm for grades 1, 2 & 3 and at 2:00pm for Grade 4, 5, 6 and 7.

School finished at 12:45pm on a Friday for all grades.

Children may be dropped off from 7.00am.

We follow the GDE school terms.

AFTERCARE

The school runs an aftercare service from 1pm till 5.30pm. The children are supplied with a light lunch and fruit as well as refreshments at tea time. Homework is supervised from 2.15pm till 3.30pm from Monday to Thursday.

Fulltime aftercare is R11 770 for the year over 11 months. Daily charge is R86.00.

We ask that punctuality in fetching your child be strictly observed. Parents who do not comply, will be asked to remove their child from this facility.

BEHAVIOUR

It is important that teachers and parents stand together as a united front with regards to discipline.

If bullying or any other serious offence occurs, the parents will be called in with the child and the matter dealt with. No child has the right to make other children unhappy or afraid to come to school. If your child shows signs of being insecure or unhappy, we must be made aware of the circumstances immediately.

Please do not hesitate to discuss all aspects of your child with us. By dealing with the "whole child", we will help him to grow and develop in all areas of his being.

EXTRA MURAL ACTIVITIES

Children may participate in the extra mural activities offered by Craighall Primary School.
